



Ljubodrag Andric

Ljubodrag Andric was born in Belgrade, Yugoslavia on July 21, 1965; his father was a writer and dramaturge and his mother actress. His involvement with photography started at age 15. He studied literature at the university of Belgrade before dedicating himself to photography entirely. He moved permanently to Rome, Italy in 1986. In 2002 he moved to Toronto, Canada where he now resides. He is citizen of both Italy and Canada.

Following recent gallery exhibitions in San Francisco and Toronto, in 2016 Andric's work was presented with an exhibition at the Triennale 2016 as well as at the Bocconi University art space, both in Milan, Italy. Most recently a large exhibition of Andric's was held at the Fondazione Querini Stampalia in Venice, Italy – curated by Francesca Valente and installed in collaboration with architect Tobia Scarpa.

Another comprehensive exhibition of Andric's is currently held at Musée des beauxarts in Le Locle, Switzerland (February 18 – May 29 2017), part of a three exhibition program – paired with Annie Albers and Sol LeWitt, in survey about abstraction.

A comprehensive monograph about his work has been released in May 2016, published by SKIRA.

Ljubodrag Andric is represented by Robert Koch Gallery in San Francisco and by Nicholas Metivier Gallery in Canada. His works have been presented at MIA PHOTO fair 2017 by Podbielski Contemporary gallery.
